# Green Transition in Belgium, Denmark, and Croatia

**Building European Democracy** 

**DRAFT PROGRAMME**: Delegations from Crosol from Croatia, Europahuis Ryckevelde from Belgium, and The Democracy in Europe Organisation from Denmark meet to discuss perspectives and challenges in the green transition in Europe. How far from complete is the green transition in the three countries? What are the main obstacles? What can be done at the European level to save the planet?

Since January the three partner organisations have been working on the e-book "Green transition in the EU". The book was finished and published in July 2023. At this 3-day workshop we invite activists, followers, and ordinary members of our organisations to launch the book and start a European-wide dialogue on how to proceed with climate initiatives and the green transition in the EU.

DEO organises **transport in minibuses** from the airport to the venue and back again and takes care of **venue** and **accommodation** - this is *free of charge* for all participants.

**Bed linen**: It is possible to **rent** a full set of duvets, pillow, sheet, towels, and a dry cloth for **130 DKK** (17.50 euro) from the venue. Otherwise, you must **bring your own** bed linen (a sheet, a pillow, and a sleeping bag), a towel, and a dry cloth for doing dishes.

DEO organises **shopping and cooking** of breakfast, lunch, and supper. The food is *free of charge* for all participants.

DEO will bring some **beer**, wine, and soft drinks that participants can **purchase** at the same price as in the supermarkets. Beer or soft drink: 1 euro. A bottle of white or red wine: 10 euro.

All participants will be assigned to two tasks during the stay: One task is to assist with a meal (approximately 1 hour) and one task is doing the dishes after a meal (approximately 45 minutes).
